WAY OUT WEST COALITION HOSTS PUBLIC SAFETY EVENT

On April 2nd, the Prevention Department and Way Out West Coalition hosted a Public Safety Event at Walmart in Buckeye.

The event raised awareness about the dangers of underage drinking, and driving under the influence of alcohol. Buckeye Police, Fire and Department of Public Safety volunteered their time and efforts to help carry out this event and brought vehicles to display, and Buckeye Fire fully demonstrated a mock DUI car crash and rescue, from the accident victims to the air evacuation helicopter.

Various agencies in the West Valley also handed out materials about the community services that they offer and helpful information to be shared with residents on how to talk about and prevent these issues.

There also was a DUI Simulator car that let participants experience the difficulties and dangers of driving under the influence of alcohol.
